




• 5 Mona Lisa Art Tiles


Example of Ancient Art tiles




- 3 Museum Cards for London: 1 Modern, 1 Classic, 1 Ancient

6 Different Colored Meeples


OBJECTIVE

Create the best art exhibits with your teammate to solidify your city as the new art capital of the world!

SETUP

- 1. Players form equal sized teams. One team will be New York, and the other team will be London.
- 2. Shuffle each team's Museum tiles and deal one to each player, determining which Art Eras players have.
- 3. Shuffle the 7 random Art Form tiles and deal 1 to each player, determining which secondary objective (Art Form) players have. Put the ones not dealt to a player back in the box. These will not be used in the game.






4. Shuffle all of the art tiles together.

5. Remove 5 random art tiles and place them back in the box. These will not be used in the game.

6. Use the shuffled art tiles to create a 3 by 5 grid, with each art tile placed face up, except for the tiles that players start on.

7. Each player will take a meeple to represent themselves. Place these meeples on the grid like in the example below. (Each team is represented by a different color)



8. Give each player a ready marker and place it face up.

9. The team with the player who most recently went to an art museum will go first, and receive the Team Start token.

HOW TO PLAY

Round Structure:

1. The team with the Start Team token will decide who on their team will take their turn first. That player will take their turn and turn their Ready marker face down.

2. The other team will decide who on their team will take their turn. That player will take their turn and turn their Ready marker face down.

3. Repeat steps 1 and 2, until everyone on both teams has gone.


4. At this point, the team with the Start Team token will give it to the other team, all players will turn their Ready marker back face up, and the next round will commence.

Player turn:

Each player will take *3 actions* on their turn. The same action can be repeated more than once, and a player must use all 3 actions. The actions are the following:

Move:

Players may move into 1 tile in the cardinal direction (NESW). If a tile a player moves onto is face down, they may choose to flip it over and leave it face up or leave it face down.



Collect Art:

Players may pick up the tile they are standing on, adding that art tile to their collection, placing it face up in front of them. They can only pick up a tile if it is face up. After picking up a tile, place a new tile from the art stack in that spot, face down.

Trade:

If two players on the same team are in the same tile, they may use the Trade action. To Trade, the active player swaps one of their art pieces with one that another player on their team has. Players can only trade with players on the same tile as them. If players want to trade more than 1 piece of art, they will have to use as many actions as art pieces they want to trade



GAME END

The game ends when a player picks up an art tile, and there are none left in the stack to replenish it. The current players turn ends, and scoring commences.

WIN CONDITION

The team with the most victory points wins the game.

SCORING

Scoring will be done at the end of the game by each player individually first, then all the players on a team will add up their score to get their team score.

Art Piece Score

There are also set bonus for both Art Eras and Art Form objectives

Art Eras Objective Set Bonus:

Amount of Art Eras collected	Number of Bonus Victoru Points
3 or more	2 Bonus Points
6 or more	6 Bonus Points
9 or more	10 Bonus Points

Only the highest value bonus achieved is scored for Art Eras Objective

Art Form Objective Set Bonus:

Amount of Art Form collected	Number of Bonus Victoru Points
2 or more	2 Bonus Points
4 or more	6 Bonus Points
6 or more	10 Bonus Points
